

## Pain Fellowship Co-Directors Corner: Dr. Quynh Pham

#### How did your interest grow in PM&R?

When I was a medical student at UCLA, we did not have any faculty specialized in PM&R. I learned about the field through my 77 year old roommate who at the time was evaluated by a physiatrist for her leg pain. I did an elective at the VA and was impressed by the easy-going personality of the staff and residents in this field and their ability to establish wonderful rapport and long term relationships with their patients. I particularly love that the role of a physiatrist is to give others a second chance at life whether it be restoring the ability to ambulate, live with less pain, or become independent again.

# What are your responsibilities as the pain fellowship director?

As program director, my responsibility is to ensure that we create the best training environment for our residents and fellows. Some of my responsibilities include ensuring that our program meets all ACGME requirements, maintaining updated records for our trainees, creating a safe and supportive educational experience, implementing program policies, developing the educational curriculum and rotation schedules, recruiting and selecting trainees each year and ensuring competencies of our trainees. It takes much more than a program director and hospital funding to create a successful training program. I am very grateful for all the amazing staff who spend so much time and effort to make our program a successful one.

# You've mentored all levels of trainees including undergraduate students, medical students, residents and fellows. What do you find most meaningful about mentorship?

I believe that as educators, we have the powerful ability to shape impressionable young minds. I find it immensely rewarding to offer support and guidance to students as they navigate the challenges of obtaining higher education. I was the first in my



family to pursue a career in medicine and went through many trials and errors on this path, so I wanted to help others avoid it. To me, an accomplishment is not gaining a title or receiving an award or accolade but rather opening the door of opportunity for a student to give them a better chance at achieving their goals.

## What has been the most rewarding or fulfilling part of your career?

Since English was my second language, I was extremely shy and insecure growing up. I stuttered and could not even say "here" when the teacher called roll. I never imagined that I would be able to speak in front of a group of people. As a PM&R resident, I learned to speak up and address the team during team meetings. The most rewarding part of my career is overcoming shyness and having the opportunity to teach patients, students and trainees. I am also fortunate to learn a skill set that can help others better manage their impairment or pain. Most of all, I am grateful to be working with the most passionate, bright and dedicated colleagues.

#### Any updates about the pain fellowship?

We have increased our complement from 4 fellows to 5 fellows and added an additional rotation at UCLA. We are still trying to iron out some minor kinks, but so far, everything is going well. In addition, we have added an Interdisciplinary Headache Clinic to the rotation and are anticipating that the fellows will have more hands-on experience with spine procedures and botulinum injections.






