Please use this table to ensure you have all the necessary documentation for health clearance as required by UCLA Health System. Clinical instructors and students must provide all documentation to their school and the school must have these available on request.

COVID-19 Vaccination	
	Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination (Completed series plus booster)
	OR COVID-19 Vaccine Letter of Exemption - If the university or school has a COVID-19 exemption letter, we will accept that form.
	Disease history of COVID-19 will not be accepted.
Influenza	
	Every year from November 1st until March 31st, healthcare personnel must either be vaccinated for influenza or wear a surgical mask when in direct contact with patients, providing direct patient service (within 6 feet), or in a patient room at Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center; UCLA Medical Center, Santa Monica; UCLA Resnick Neuropsychiatric Hospital; and UCLA West Valley Medical Center.**
Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)	
	Medication documentation of two (2) doses of MMR vaccination
	OR Medical documentation of one (1) blood titers that indicate immunity to MMR
	Disease history of measles, mumps, and rubella will not be accepted.
TB- Tuberculosis Test	
	Medical documentation of a Negative QuantiFERON Gold (also known as t-spot) blood test in the last 12 months
Tetatus, Diphtheria, Pertussis Vaccine (TDaP)	
	Medical documentation of TDaP vaccination within the last 10 years
	OR Signed TDaP declination is unable to provide medical documentation
Varicella	
	Medical documentation of two (2) doses of Varicella vaccination
	OR medical documentation of one (1) blood titer that indicate immunity to Varicella
	Disease history of Varicella will not be accepted.

^{**} Students and/or clinical instructors are not eligible to receive the free flu shot services provided by UCLA Health or redeem the CVS voucher. Flu vaccines must be received privately by the student and/or instructor. Students and/or clinical instructors may obtain a flu badge for the season through UCLA Health Occupational Health and present proof of flu vaccine.
