This opportunity was created in partnership with UCLA Department of Radiation Oncology and Department of Radiation Oncology EDI committee, to serve as a recruitment tool for UCLA Radiation Oncology residency programs. The \$1,500 stipend opportunity supports travel and lodging expenses and additional funding support for \$1,000 to four **4th year out of state and in-state medical students** who hail from underrepresented experiences and backgrounds. All are encouraged to apply.
