#### **Eligibility**

All U.S. medical students with a commitment to fostering workforce diversity in healthcare professions are encouraged to apply, especially those coming from groups that are underrepresented in medicine (UIM) from a social, economic, or educational perspective.

All students must also meet the following criteria:

- 4th year medical student in good academic standing at an accredited US medical school
- Completed core clerkships in internal medicine, obstetrics/gynecology, pediatrics, psychiatry, and surgery
- Passed USMLE Step 1 prior to rotation

#### **Application Process**

The following materials are required at least 45 days prior to the desired rotation's start date, but preferably prior to June 15.

- VSSP Application Form
  - This includes a Statement of Interest that speaks to your interests and the importance of improving health equity as well as the applicant's specific interest in the UCLA DAPM Residency Program.
- UCLA DGSOM Visiting Student Application, using VSLO elective listing ANES 450.01: Anesthesiology sub-internship at Ronald Reagan. This must include:
  - One letter of recommendation from a faculty member
  - An official academic transcript
  - A recent CV

#### **Program Timeline**

- Anesthesiology Elective is available year-round.
- Scholarship recipients will be selected by the VSSP committee on a rolling basis starting June 15.
- Applicants are encouraged to apply by June 15 to maximize their likelihood of consideration for the scholarship.
